

NCLL CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS, SPECTATORS & ATHLETES



The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to promote the spirit of friendly competition, sportsmanship and a learning environment at the NCLL complex.

Encourage and promote the following conduct:

- Treat coaches, umpires and players with respect and courtesy
- Use positive reinforcement when cheering a team or player
- Encourage behaviors and practices that promote a safe & healthy environment
- Discuss game ruling disagreements after the game, in a professional manner, at the clubhouse, with the Manager or NCLL Board Member present
- Promote good sportsmanship
- Strive to maintain an environment that is fun, especially for the players
- Applaud and cheer good efforts on the field

The following behaviors **WILL NOT** be tolerated:

- Any type of harassment of MANAGERS or GAME UMPIRES
- Ridicule or yelling negative comments
- Verbal or physical hostility
- Player criticism
- Any presence or use of drugs or alcohol
- Poor sportsmanship
- Profanity
- Prejudice or discrimination
- Any behavior that adversely impacts safety

I agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned Code of Conduct, ***I WILL BE SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION THAT COULD INCLUDE, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING:***

- Verbal warning by Manager, NCLL Board Member or official
- Player/Parental game suspension
- Player/Parental seasonal suspension
